Nicky Interviewing Sambrook's Brewery Employees on 23rd July 2014

Employee One - Kevin trained Young's Shire Horses, he's got them down on a farm somewhere. He used to do shows with them. The horse and cart used to go all the way to parson's green.

At young's brewery there was a Cartesian screw to pull the water up from the Wandle.

When anyone died who worked at Young's, the Young's horses would draw a glass carriage and we'd all come out and salute and have a minute's silence.

Johnny still works at Young's in Wandsworth, he's the custodian.

Employee Two - We have a shop and a bar here at Sambrook's and hold open evenings on the 3rd Wednesday of each month.

A local farmer collects the spent grains to use for cattle feed. He used to collect from Young's too, he started in 1966
