Here the Pickle and the Priory Wall run parallel south and turn west together along Liberty Avenue. Although the former here runs in an underground culvert.

Being an archaeology sensitive area and with redevelopment about to take place a dig was carried out early in 2014.

Two trenches were dug with only one having foundations from the wall, along with a brick built drain channel. The latter had the bricks removed a couple hours after the photographs were taken.

The side infills could be there to act as stabilisers with the wall so close to marshy ground.

I was informed that no dig would take place were the wall turned to the west as nothing would be built here. It did not make any difference they built there anyway.
