

## Wandle Valley Regional Park Trust's ambitious project begins in south west London

This month marks the start of a new project for the Wandle Valley Regional Park Trust (WVRPT) in south west London, with Barker Langham, LDA Design and Architecture 00.

As a result of a grant from the Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF), Resilient Heritage program and cash partnership funding the Wandle Valley Regional Park Trust has sought an expert consultant team that will support it to become a more robust and sustainable organisation, in conjunction with delivering its strategy:

Over the next 10 months, Barker Langham, LDA Design and Architecture 00 will work together to shape the future of the WVRPT, improving its business and funding model and creating a partnership that will enhance social investment and financial security. 


