
ADDINGTON HILLS

GEOLOGY AND TOPOGRAPHY



This is a magnificent panoramic view north, seen from a sandstone ridge at the edge of the North Downs. It reveals the geology and topography of the Wandle Valley within London's wider Thames Valley system, and you can also see many London landmarks in the distance.

Explore 130 acres of natural landscape with oak/birch/pine woodland and London's largest heathland, which supports a wide range of plant, animal, insect and bird species. It is also on section 4 of the London Loop Recreational Path.
