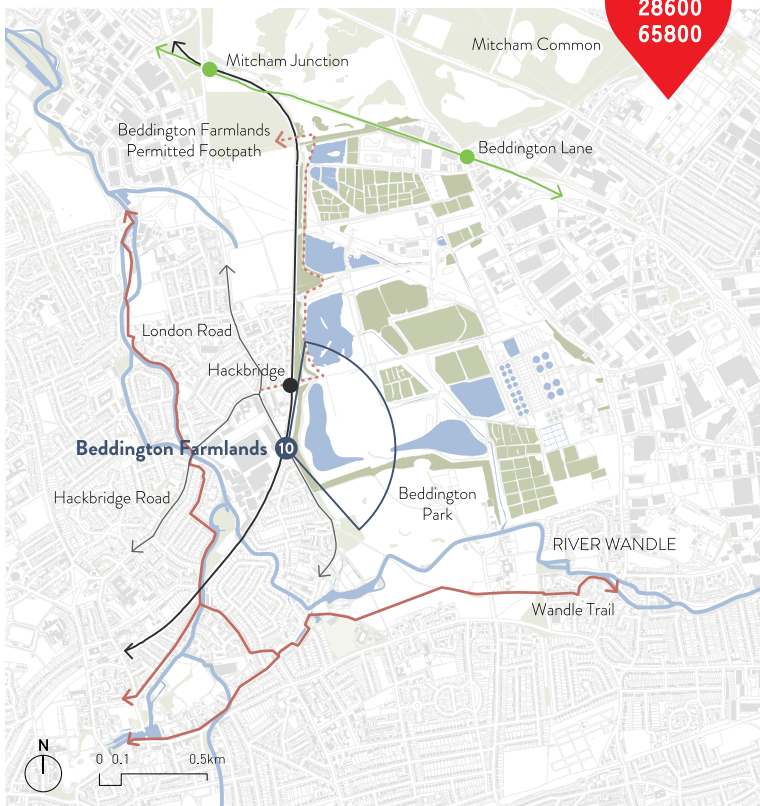


BEDDINGTON FARMLANDS

From this viewpoint you can watch a new landscape being created, as the extraction and landfill site of Beddington Farmlands is restored into a nature reserve. The viewpoint looks across artificial waterbodies and mounds which support hundreds of birds. In the distance dumper trucks move rubbish and spoil to create new landforms. Croydon and the historic Beddington Park are to the south, with wooded ridges forming the skyline beyond.

This is a temporary viewpoint; in time there will be a publicly-accessible viewing point within the nature reserve.
