

4 ST MARKS ROAD CAR PARK

FROM RURAL RETREAT TO URBAN CENTRE



An example of an ‘everyday’, serendipitous viewpoint. From the top deck of the car park there are excellent views in all directions. Nearby is Eagle House, built in 1705 as a country retreat with a viewing cupola on the roof. Since that time the scene has changed from rural to urban, but it’s still a great view.

From here you can see familiar Wandle Valley landmarks, and wider London landmarks including Wembley Stadium arch, the post office tower, Battersea Power Station, skyscrapers in the City of London, and the Shard.
