

WANDLE DELTA

INDUSTRIAL HISTORY OF THE WANDLE



This river prospect from the north bank of the Thames is directly opposite the confluence of the Thames and Wandle. The view is dynamic, changing with the tides and weather. Historically it has been a key industrial area with wharves for ships to tie up and transfer cargoes. Today it is being redeveloped with high-rise residential blocks.

The Wandle appears unobtrusive in the view but the river, bridges, wharves, bankside trees and 'spit' are visible. Glimpses of Wandsworth town centre to the south include the tower of St. Anne's church.
